Suggested Objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Learn the name of colours - Reflect about the role of colours in everyday life - Comparison - Increase cooperative learning skill - Creativity awakening 																																		
Procedure	<p>Suggestion 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> § Give all learners one of the pictures below. It should be the same picture for all. § Ask them to name the colours that should be visible in that picture.
