

NEWSLETTER

This is the second newsletter of the Valorize Non Formal and Informal Learning (NFIL) project in the framework of the Erasmus+ Strategy partnerships programme.

The **Kick off Meeting** of the project was held in Torino (Italy) in the premises of the coordinator partner Fondazione Casa di Carita Arti e Mestieri onlus, where the coordinator gave a detail explanation about the project and their aims and goals.

CEC, the partner from Belgium, responsible by the Intellectual Output number 1 **“Study Report”**, presented the Intellectual Output and explained to all the consortium the tasks that each partner had to do. Every partner had to contribute with their work until the end of December, and then partners leader would elaborate a report with all the information delivered by the partners.

The report consisted in giving a more insight in current validation arrangements and to make visible the opportunities for the validation of migrants and disadvantaged groups per country. It will be available in the project website, valorizenfil.eu/materials.

During this timeframe, the **Intellectual Output number 2** has also started. IMI and CECE, are the partner leaders of this Output which the objective is to test a synthetic and updated method of harvest of synthetic and updated method of harvest of professional skills and profiles that can be certified in the countries involved in the project; documentation useful for the validation action in each country; processes and/or services that each country can offer for this type of service.

This output will be the basis for the database that will be developed during the project, and that later will be available in the project website. From this database the target group of the project, can have information about the accreditation of **20 professional profiles** in all partner countries. The idea is to increase this number, thus supporting the exploitation of the project.

The list of 20 professional profiles developed among the consortium, is divided into **4 sectors**: Trade, Catering/Hotel, ICT and Social-Health Field. The final list can be founded bellow:
