LEARNING SYSTEM FOR VET PROVIDERS



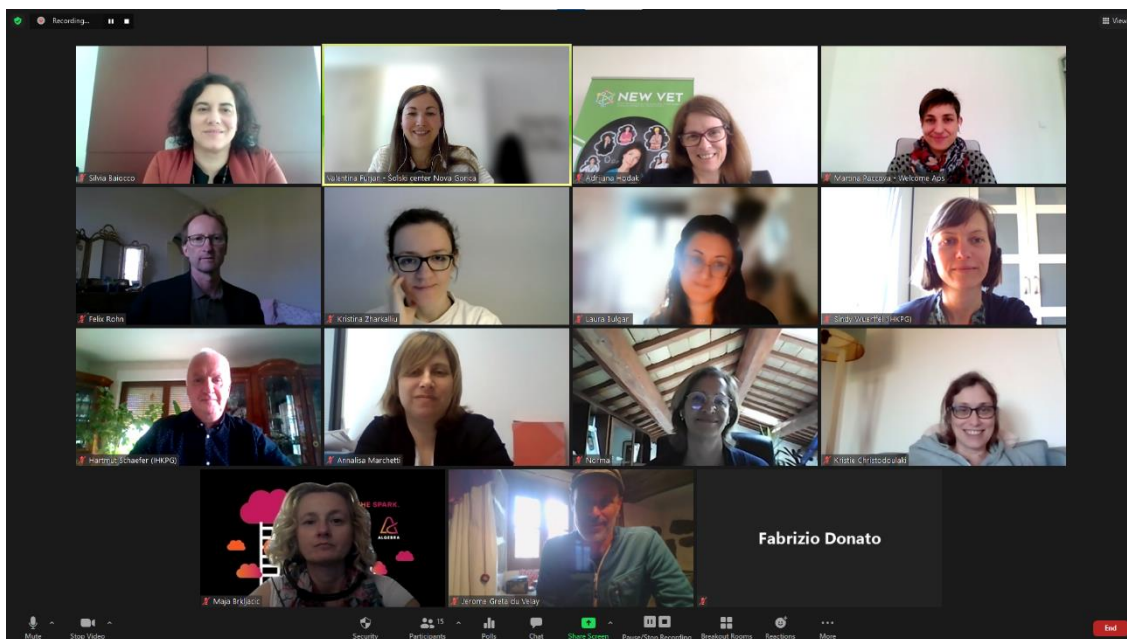

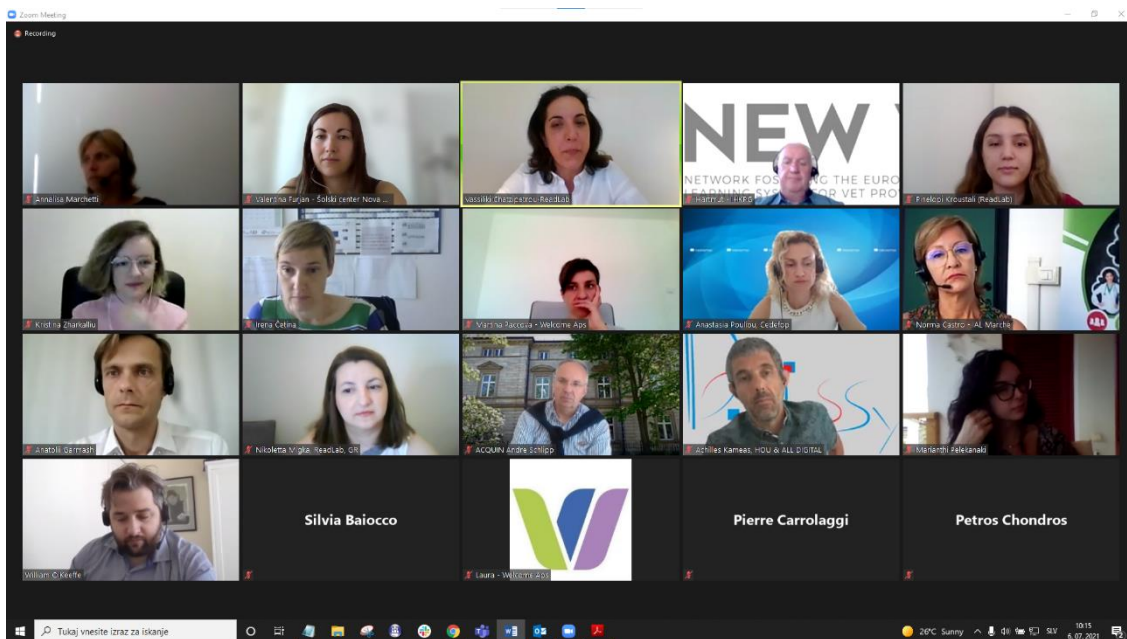
